



- When operating with CCG, the included "SubstiTUBE® Start" has to be inserted as well. If the conventional starter is not replaced the SubstiTUBE® Star will start blinking. Switch off immediately, the SubstiTUBE® Star can be damaged!




Installation Instructions for CGG

- Make sure that the supply voltage is disconnected.
- Carefully remove the fluorescent tube and starter according to the lamp holder type.
- ➤ Insert SubstiTUBE® Star and SubstiTUBE® Start properly.

Below an example for typical lamp holder types is described

- > Turn the conventional lamp 90° degrees and take it out of the socket.
- Remove the conventional starter by turning it.
- ➤ Insert and latch the SubstiTUBE® Start into starter socket.
- ➤ Insert SubstiTUBE® Star into socket and locate into position by turning 90°.
- Check light emission direction.
